Hi Lynn

As stated in February, the case file audits from the OCG were to be carried out on children who were in the care of the Minister as the primary criteria.

Hunter ACS has some children who would fit this criteria who are staying with carers owned by Hunter ACS. However we are not case managing or case working these clients. They are managed and worked by DoCS.

The only children who Hunter ACS does case work and case management on are the children who are under a court order to the Principle Officer of Hunter ACS (me). That is effectively that Hunter ACS has children who are under the Parental Responsibility of the Principle Officer of Hunter ACS.

As the criteria set out by the OCG in February was "care to the Minister" it is my belief that we still do not have cases that fall within the criteria for case file audits at this stage. If this differs from your thoughts please call me so we can discuss any changes.
