Prohibited Employment Declaration

As required by the NSW Government's Child Protection (Prohibited Employment) Act, all appointed adult members of Scouting in NSW (as at 26 April 2001) were direct mailed on 4 May a "Prohibited Employment Declaration" form with a request to sign and return it in a reply paid envelope direct to the State Office by no later than 31 May 2001. Any member who was issued with the form and fails to sign it will not be allowed to continue in Scouting.

These new forms must be used from this point on - old forms without the declaration will not be accepted.
