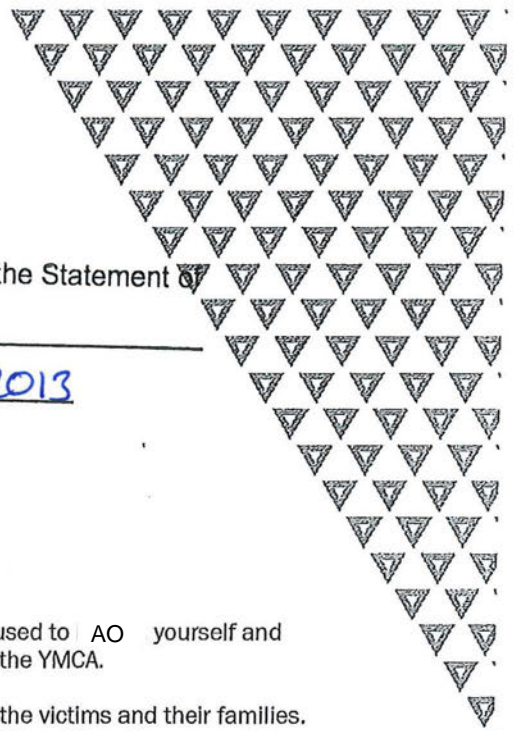

Dear AN

On behalf of the YMCA I would like to personally apologise for the trauma caused to AO yourself and your family and the email sent to you today as part of a survey conducted by the YMCA.

The YMCA has been aware of the trauma Jonathon's actions have caused to the victims and their families. I assure you we sought permission from NSW Police to contact the families of the victims the moment we became aware that some of the children assaulted by Jonathon came into contact with Jonathon through his work in our Childcare centers. This permission was sought in November 2011. This permission was denied by NSW Police and the names of the children were withheld from the YMCA, and continue to be withheld from the YMCA by NSW Police.

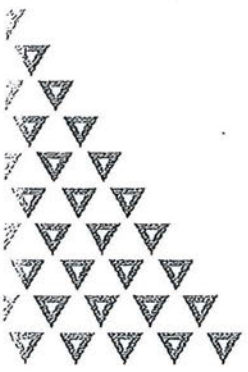
Our communication regarding the Charges against Jonathon has been centrally managed by our Communication team who at no stage was aware of the victims' names, or removed you from the communication list. I am unaware of how you were not included in the communication list and wanted to respond to you immediately and reassure you that we will investigate your concerns immediately.
