The NOK was unsure, however, the POI may have put his hand on the inside the victims Jeans between his jeans and underpants.

Upon hearing this version of events, the NOK has taken the victim home and informed her husband.

The victim has then gone to the YMCA and spoken with the manager, Shane DEMIR and Jacki. The victim informed them of what the victim had stated. DEMIR and JACKI advised they would have to speak with the POI about the issue. The NOK has then attended Miranda Police Station.

While at the station the NOK informed Detectives of the above version of events. Detectives spoke with the YMCA and advised them not to inform the POI of the Police investigation. The YMCA stated

they would be standing the POI down until further notice but would not divulge the details of the allegation.

Police have seized the clothing worn by the Victim and these have been entered into EFIMS.

Police have requested the details of the other carers that were on the excursion today.

Police have attended the home address of the POI in an attempt to intercept him with his mobile phone, however, he was not home.

Police have contacted the DOCS help line due to the nature of the offence. Police were given reference number 1-UUAUBC and informed that JIRT would be notified.

Police have informed the NOK that a decision will be made over the weekend in relation to carriage of the investigation, and pending this the victim will be formally interviewed.

At this stage Police do not hold any immediate fears for the Victim due to the fact that the POI has been stood down, and the NOK advised that the Victim will not be returning to the Vacation care facility.

The children have not been interviewed or spoken to by Miranda Detectives at this time, pending decision by JIRT as to who has carriage of the investigation. All steps to preserve physical evidence have been taken, and there is no immediate need to interview the POI at this time.
