The victim in this matter is AF. The victim is an 8 year old child who resides at home with his parents. The victim has a younger brother CHILD2.

The POI in this matter is Jonathon LORD. LORD is employed by the YMCA as a child care co-ordinator..

On the morning of Friday 30th September 2011, the NOK dropped the victim and his brother at the hall attached to Laguna Street Public School Caringbah. It is believed that YMCA are using

Case Narrative : this hall in relation to vacation care activities. The NOK dropped the victim off at approximately 08:15am.

The NOK states that she received a call on her mobile at 8:04am from the POI. The number that appeared on her phone was [REDACTED]. The NOK stated that the POI confirmed if the victim and Child2 were attending which she confirmed.

The victim has then gone on an excursion associated with the YMCA to a Circus Training Centre. The POI has also gone on this trip.

The NOK attended Laguna Street Public School about 5:00pm and collected the victim and Child2. During the drive home the Victim has advised the NOK of the following version:

The victim states that during the bus ride home the POI was taking photographs of the Victim and Child2 on what he believed to be the POI's mobile phone.

The victim then states that the POI has asked him if he has ever played "Tonsil Hockey?" The victim states that he said "No and I do not want to."

It is believed at this stage the victim was sitting on the POI's lap and the POI has used his hand to rub on the outside of the victim's jeans in his groin area.

The victim states that the POI has then placed his hand inside the victim's right pants pocket and continued to rub his genital area. The POI has also put his hand up the victim's shirt and touched his chest and stomach area.

The NOK was unsure, however, the POI may have put his hand on the inside the victim's jeans between his jeans and underpants.

Upon hearing this version of events, the NOK has taken the victim home and informed her husband.

The victim has then gone to the YMCA and spoken with the manager, Shane DEMIR and Jacki. The victim informed them of what the victim had stated. DEMIR and JACKI advised they would have to speak with the POI about the issue. The NOK has then attended Miranda Police Station.

While at the station the NOK informed Detectives of the above version of events. Detectives spoke w

Case Narrative : ith the YMCA and advised them not to inform the POI of the Police investigation. The YMCA stated they would be standing the POI down until further notice but would not divulge the details of the allegation.

Police have seized the clothing worn by the Victim and these have been entered into EFIMS.

Police have requested the details of the other carers that were on the excursion today.

Police have attended the home address of the POI in an attempt to intercept him with his mobile phone, however, he was not home.

Police have contacted the DOCS help line due to the nature of the offence. Police were given reference number 1-UUAUBC and informed that JIRT would be notified.

Police have informed the NOK that a decision will be made over the weekend in relation to carriage of the investigation, and pending this the victim will be formally interviewed.

At this stage Police do not hold any immediate fears for the Victim due to the fact that the POI has been stood down, and the NOK advised that the Victim will not be returning to the Vacation care facility.

The children have not been interviewed or spoken to by Miranda Detectives at this time, pending decision by JIRT as to who has carriage of the investigation. All steps to preserve physical evidence have been taken, and there is no immediate need to interview the POI at this time.

Case Narrative : The Victim Child (VC) in this matter is AF [REDACTED] an 8 year old child. The DEFENDANT in this matter is Jonathon LORD. LORD is employed by the YMCA as a child care co-ordinator.

Incident 1:

AGGRAVATED INDECENT ASSAULT

On the morning of Friday the 30th September 2011, the VC and his younger brother attended the YMCA school holiday program at Caringbah.

About 8.30am the VC and his younger brother, AG have boarded a bus with the POI and numerous other children to attend an excursion at the circus factory in Hornsby. The VC was sitting in the rear of the bus, on the lap of the DEFENDANT, and beside AG and another young boy. The young boys were playing Pokemon Cards. Sometime during the trip the DEFENDANT has placed his hand into the pocket of the jeans the VC was wearing. The DEFENDANT has rubbed his hand over the groin area of the VC for approximately one minute. The DEFENDANT has then placed his hand down the front of the VC's jeans and pulled his underwear down and started rubbing the VC's penis. The VC told him to stop and asked him to play cards, as he would need to use his hands to hold the cards. The DEFENDANT joined in the card game for the rest of the trip.

Incident 2:

AGGRAVATED INDECENT ASSAULT

In the afternoon of Friday the 30th September 2011, the VC was sitting on the rear of the bus. The VC was next to the window, sitting beside the VC was the DEFENDANT, sitting the other side of the DEFENDANT was the VC's brother [REDACTED]. The DEFENDANT has put his hand inside the VC jeans pocket and rubbed his penis for a couple of seconds, using his right thumb. The VC has shifted his body away from the DEFENDANT.

Case Narrative : On Monday the 10th October 2011 [REDACTED] the Witness Child, (WC) attended Kogarah JIRT to participate in an AV DVD interview. The WC was able to distinguish between truth and lies. Intrak RO 205332 commenced.

The WC's version supports the VC version stating on the morning of Friday the 30th September they both attended the YMCA as part of a school holiday program. Upon arrival they both boarded a bus to attend the circus factory in Hornsby. The WC stated on the trip he sat on the window seat at the rear of the bus next to him was another young person named [REDACTED] or something similar. The WC had just met him on this trip,

Case Narrative : next to [REDACTED] was the DEFENDANT and the VC was sitting on his lap. The WC recalls playing cards with [REDACTED] and his brother but did not see the DEFENDANT indecently assault the VC.

In the afternoon on the return trip back on the bus. The WC states he was sitting on the rear of the bus, next to him was the DEFENDANT and the VC was the other side of the DEFENDANT, next to the window. The WC said the DEFENDANT was tickling the VC, another adult was calling the DEFENDANT "Sexy John". The WC did not see the DEFENDANT indecently assault the VC.
