The below attachment concerns a forum being held by a group called 'Parents for Parents' arising from the YMCA investigation. The intention of the meeting as per the notice from the St George & Sutherland Shire Leader (10 November '11) is:

'To discuss ways of improving Child Protection in Before and After School Care Centres following the arrest of a child care worker in our shire community for alleged child abuse (aggravated indecent assault) on children in BASC. The meeting will facilitate a discussion of these ideas and ways of achieving timely and effective implementation.'

The event will be at 8.00pm Thursday 24 November 2011 at Cronulla Central Hall, 30-60 Croydon St Cronulla off Cronulla Mall.

At the last court mention the order was continued preventing the release and publication Australia wide of the offender and victims details. It was not a closed court though.

I intend to contact the email address and speak with the organiser. I will reinforce, if needed, that victims/parents/witnesses should not attend the forum as it may be detrimental to future court processes, that they should not discuss the investigation, and not to breach the suppression order. We will not attend.
