0900 CALL RECEIVED FROM LIAISON WHEPLEY YMLA MANAGER FOR CHILDREN'S SERVICES RE LONDON 'PARENTS FOR PARENTS' FORUM. EXPLAINED THAT I TOOK THE MEETING WITH [REDACTED] THAT THEIR INTENTION IS TO EXPLORE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PRACTICE IMPROVEMENT. HE STATED THAT THEY RECEIVED A LETTER FROM AW - THAT THEY ARE PREPARING A RESPONSE ON LEGAL ADVICE. HE MENTIONED HAVING BEEN ABLE TO VISIT THE FORUM. HE WONDERS IF POSSIBLY COUNTER-PRODUCTIVE, THAT THEY MAY BREACH THE SUPPRESSION ORDER AND NOT MAINTAIN EFFECTIVE CONTROL OVER PARTICIPANTS. EXPLAINED THAT I BREKED RECOMMENDATION ON THE SUPPRESSION ORDER, THAT THEY HAVE ASSURANCE NOT TO BREACH - NOT TO DISCLOSE THE INVESTIGATION. ADVISED ALSO ON NEED FOR STRONG DELEGATION. HE MENTIONED THESE PROVIDED THREE INFORMATION SERVICES. ADVISED AS PER RECOMMENDATION DISCUSSION ON POLICE WORKING FOR THESE EVENT. CONFIRM THAT IF A DISCLOSURE OF LONDON IS MADE THEY WILL REFER TO LP HELPLINE. ASSURANCE NOT TO DISCLOSE INVESTIGATION OR BREACH SUPPRESSION ORDER. HE WILL EMAIL A COPY OF THE LETTER TO PARENTS USING THESE SERVICES AND DETAILS OF THE EVENT.
