As per the email from Georgina Wells we are not planning to distribute a further media release following the court date tomorrow. The best course would be to have your media and communications officer at the court and during the hearing instruction will be provided on obtaining access to the police facts. I spoke with D/Sgt Maloney and apparently the Magistrate at previous hearings has clearly articulated what will and will not be released.

It will obviously be vetted to remove identifying information on our victims. Any access will be obtained through the court once it is on the public record.
