Hi James

Just to recap on court proceedings this morning, I thought the following summary would be useful

(just as an FYI). As discussed, it will be worth seeking advice on the phrase "charge carrying life".

Key points:

- Adjournment sought for July 17th (6 weeks) by DPP – accepted by both defence and magistrate.
- Brief has now been read in full by prosecution (DPP) and it was heard that charges have been incorrectly laid and need to be re-laid (after settling some facts) with various changes.
- Negotiations taking some time given the age of some of the complainants.
- It was stated that there is now a "charge carrying life" (no further explanation/detail was given).
- Magistrate was firm when she said matter must be resolved at the next hearing particularly as victims are "young and vulnerable".
- Existing AVO will also remain until July 17th.
