Detectives attached to the Kogarah Joint Investigation Response Team are investigating reports two children were indecently assaulted while in child care.

Police were told the children, aged 8 and 7, were in child care organised by a Caringbah-based community organisation at the time of the alleged incidents.

The incidents were reported separately on September 30 and October 10. Specialist JIRT police and Community Services officers are speaking with the children.

26-year-old man has been assisting police with their inquiries.

Police have been advised the man has been stood down from his employment pending the outcome of the investigation.

Parents or carers with concerns of serious risk of harm to their children should contact the Child Protection Helpline on 132 111.

Joint Investigation Response Teams are specialist units comprising detectives from State Crime Command's Joint Investigation Response Squad and the Department of Family and Community Services.
