ISSUE:

Arrest and charge of Jonathon LORD (D.O.B: 04/11/1986) an employee of the YMCA as child care worker. Mr LORD was arrested for Aggravated Indecent Assaults upon a male child AF (D.O.B: [REDACTED]) and a male child AL (D.O.B: [REDACTED]).

BACKGROUND:

On the 12th of October, 2011 Kogarah Joint Investigation Response Team commenced an investigation into allegations the accused had indecently assaulted the victim AF whilst the victim was attending vocational school care at Laguna Public Street co-ordinated by the YMCA. The victim was interviewed and disclosed the accused had touched the victim's penis and put his hands inside his jeans touching his penis whilst on a bus excursion. On the return trip, on the bus, the accused has put his hand inside the victim's jeans and touched his penis.

Kogarah JIRT was notified of a further victim AL later on the 12th October, 2011. This victim was interviewed. The victim attends after school care at Caringbah Public School also co-ordinated and managed by the YMCA. AL disclosed whilst at after school care the accused has sat him on his lap and whilst reading a book has rubbed his penis on the outside of the victim's clothing. The victim further disclosed whilst he was painting the accused has rubbed the victim's penis with his hand on the outside of his clothing.

The accused has been employed by the YMCA for two (2) years as an after and before school carer and a vocational holiday carer.

Owing to communication released by the YMCA parents were notified of the police investigation. As a result, numerous parents have contacted police, Family Services and the YMCA. It is anticipated owing to the lengthy employment of the accused, further children may disclose, which will result in further victims and further charges. At this stage two further reports have been received by the JRU regarding disclosures made. Details of these children are unknown at this stage by investigating police.

The accused is suspended from any employment involving the YMCA.

Family Services and the YMCA have been fully appraised of the current situation.

CURRENT POSITION:

On Friday the 14th of October 2011 at 7.00pm the accused was arrested at Miranda Police Station in the presence of his solicitor. On the advice of his solicitor the accused declined to be electronically interviewed. The accused was charged with four (4) counts of Aggravated Indecent Assault with child under sixteen whilst in the authority of the accused. Conditional bail has been granted. Bail conditions are to surrender his passport; not to contact any victims or family member of the victims by any means whatsoever; not to approach or contact any former places of employment involving children; not to engage or seek employment that involves contact with children; not to access internet sites which may be accessed by children; to report to Miranda Police Station between 8am and 8pm on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

WELFARE ISSUES:

No issues identified.

FURTHER/PROJECTED ACTION:

It is anticipated further victims will present to police and further charges will be laid against the accused. Brief to be prepared.
