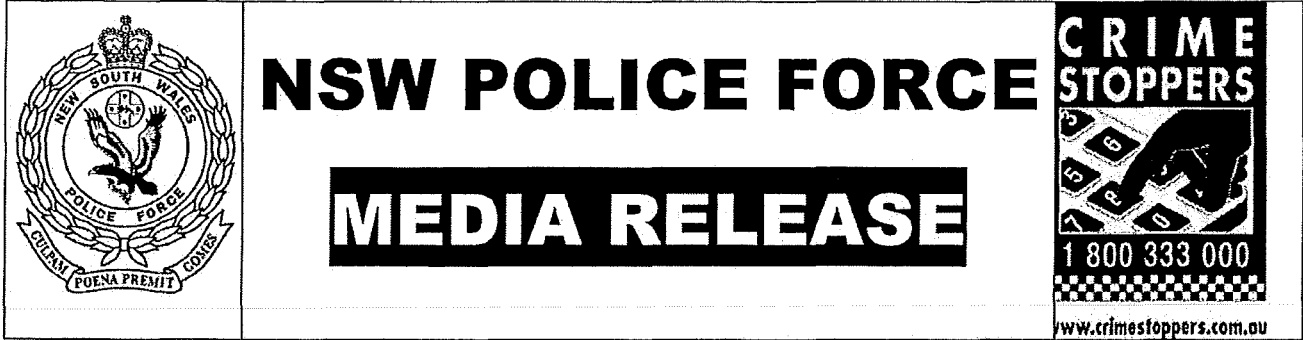
This afternoon, it is anticipated that LORD will be brought to Miranda Police Station with his barrister. He will be charged with 7 offences, all Aggravated Indecent Assaults (some as a carer) regarding the following 4 victims;

Male 9 old - son of the work colleague of the POI's mother
 Male 10 old - Sutherland PCYC
 Male 11 old - [REDACTED] neighbour
 Male 10 old - friend of POI family through the [REDACTED] Church.

This will mean a total of 11 charges to date relating to 6 victims. Will bail refuse and he will probably go to Sutherland Local Court tomorrow. His next court appearance is set for the 10 November. I'll send a sitrep through when done.

Further charges laid following indecent assaults – Kogarah Joint Investigation Response Team

Issued at xxm, Monday 24 October 2011

Detectives attached to the Kogarah Joint Investigation Response Team (JIRT) have laid further charges following investigations into alleged indecent assaults of a number of children in child care.

On Friday 14 October 2011, police charged a 24-year-old man with four counts of aggravated indecent assault following reports made to police on September 30 and October 10.

It will be alleged the two children, aged eight and 10, were in care organised by a Caringbah-based community organisation at the time of the alleged incidents.

Further inquiries have revealed four further children, aged between nine and 11, were allegedly indecently assaulted on a number of occasions.

Only one of the children was in organised child care at the time.

The 24-year-old man was arrested today (Monday 24 October 2011) at Miranda Police Station. He has since been charged with seven counts of aggravated indecent assault.

The man was refused bail to appear at Sutherland Local Court tomorrow (Tuesday 25 October 2011).

Inquiries by detectives are continuing.

Parents or carers with concerns of serious risk of harm to their children should contact the Child Protection Helpline on 132 111.

Joint Investigation Response Teams are specialist units comprising detectives from State Crime Command's Joint Investigation Response Squad and caseworkers from the Department of Family and Community Services.
