**Church of England North Coast Children's Home**

I respond to your letter dated October 10, 2007.

Firstly, as I have been asked to do; I replied to your letter dated August 14, 2007. (That letter was dated October 15, 2007). The reason I took so long to reply was because of the unfairness in your demands. It was a battle to come to terms with what you wrote.

Secondly, you wrote that you referred my queries (questions) to your solicitors concerning what was in the Deed of Release I am being urged to sign. It has been 40 days and I am still waiting for an answer.

Again I ask; I would like to see what is written in the Deed of Release that you require me to sign? As I wrote before, how can I possibly sign a document I have not read? I'm sure you would not.

Plus, it has been well over three months since I advised you of the information I have concerning the ownership of the Church of England North Coast Children's Home. It's about time you got this under way. It didn't take NASA that long to fly to the moon – and back.

I would appreciate your urgent attention on all the matters I have written about. We have a lot of ground to cover before Santa rides into town on a reindeer.

**P.S.** I have had six counselling sessions with Ms Marilyn Jackson since you gave me the go ahead for 10 sessions. I have been unable to go ahead with more because of my lack of courage to leave home and the fact that I am so damn angry and depressed with the actions of you and the Anglican Church. In that case I feel I could not possibly be realistic with what I need to express to Ms Jackson. I will continue with the counselling as soon as possible; and by Christ I need it. The Anglican Church has ruined my life.

I wait for your reply.
