Dear Richard

Thank you for your letter dated 18 September 2008.

As solicitors acting on your behalf have written to me and that letter has been responded to by the Diocesan Solicitor it is not appropriate or proper that I continue to negotiate with you. All correspondence will now be through the Diocesan Solicitor.

Additionally as the legal firm which previously represented you have contacted me in respect of certain new claimants, it is proper that all outstanding matters be dealt with by our Solicitor. It would be unfair for there to be two levels of settlement.

In respect to the closure that you and I desire, may I briefly state what the Church is prepared to provide:-

- A truthful apology
- A Deed of Release in line with that which is acceptable to you
- Payment at the highest level of the payments made to other former residents of the Home [this would not involve any loss for legal fees as happened with other residents]
- Payment by the Church of any money to be paid to Medicare in relation to this matter [\$7,730.65 as detailed on the attached letter]
- Interest on the settlement amount at seven per cent (7%) since the date of settlement by the group of claimants
- A lump sum payment to you for future counselling.

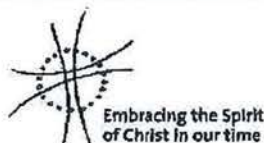
I believe the above offer is generous as it amounts to perhaps more than three times what other former residents have received.
