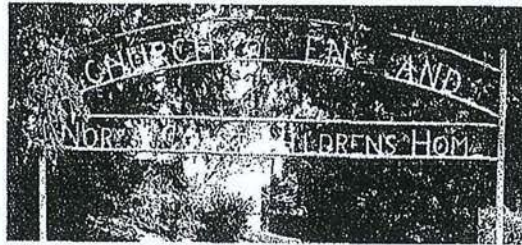

Dear Archbishop Aspinall

**Re: Church of England North Coast Children's Home/Duty of Care/Child Abuse Cover-up** (photo above)

I have written over **250 letters** to the Anglican Church explaining the reasons to why they had the duty of care of the Church of England North Coast Children's Home – and not a "community group" (who ever they may be). I have fully explained; according to **Section 28 of the Child Welfare Act** it would not have been possible for a "community group" to apply for a license or be supplied with a license. Documents obtained show licenses to run the Home were only granted to approved denominational organisations to which the Anglican Church was the one.

To date **66** of those **250 letters** were written specifically to the Bishop Keith Slater asking him to meet with me to discuss the duty of care and his "community group". He did not answer any of those letters.

\* The "community group" lies and denial of duty of care and child abuse in the **Church of England North Coast Children's Home** was kicked off by the Diocese of Grafton's **Bishop Keith Slater** and **Reverend Pat Comben** at the helm. They cannot be forgiven. It is noted in documents; when Pat Comben was speaking of children who were abused in the Home, in nine heartless words he said: **"At least they had a roof over their heads"**.

\* My letters asking for help were sent to **St. Andrew's Anglican Church** Lismore Diocese went unanswered.

\* My letters filtered on to you, **The Most Reverend Dr. Phillip Aspinall – Primate of Australia** – the leader. You refused to speak with me no matter how many letters I wrote (and you know there were many dozens).

\* Than there is **Archbishop Peter Jensen** of the Sydney Diocese. He said he was "personally concerned" with what was happening. However, he didn't want to know anything about the abuse of children in the Home, but pretended he did.

\* There is **Chaplain Jenni Woodhouse**, **Mr Philip Selden** and **Mr Rod McLary** from the Anglican Church **Professional Services** in Sydney and Brisbane who turned a blind-eye to the abuse of the children in the Home also. I believe they were doing as they were told.

\* I wrote to **The Venerable Greg Ezzy** from the Grafton Diocese. He attempted to turn the blame on me.

\* My complaint dated December 21, 2008 sent to the **Episcopal Standards Commission** went unanswered.

\* My complaint dated December 3, 2008 sent to the **Director of Professional Standards** in Grafton also went unanswered.

\* My prayers to **God** asking for the Anglican Church to tell the truth went unanswered. He doesn't care either.

I reported the duty of care and the abuse of children to all those people noted above - some of them many times over. All turned a blind-eye and sent me packing. (I point out that no one acknowledged the Anglican Church's own duty of care to help victim's of abuse)

**Primate, you succeeded that nasty creepy self-opinionated man, Archbishop Peter Hollingworth as Archbishop of Brisbane. You were appointed Primate in 2005 about the same time the Anglican Church's lies of the duty of care started to unravel. It was also about that time you were hailed as a champion of the rights of people abused in Anglican institutions. You'd better get cracking.**

This, Primate Aspinall, is a cover-up of huge proportions – a deeply deceptive plan in which is a deliberate concealment of child abuse and duty of care. While the Anglican Church continues to ignore documented facts from **Freedom of Information, DOCS archives, Section 28 of the Child Welfare Act and former DOCS manager of 11 years in Lismore, Mr. Tony Madden J.P. who worked closely with the Home**, they are maliciously with-holding information and lying about the truth of duty of care to conceal their involvement in the acts of child abuse in the Church of England North Coast Children's Home.

Former DOCS manager and Justice of the Peace, Mr Madden said: **"To my knowledge the Anglican Church had the duty of care"**. And, **"I am prepared to say to any investigative panel that I am quite certain of these facts and I don't believe that the Anglican Church can distant itself from duty of care responsibilities"**. And, **"I am stunned how hard the church worked at denying it"**.

As the Anglican Church continues to lie using their fictitious "community group" as an excuse they are betraying the victims of abuse, the public, the media, and the decent members of the clergy.

One of the sad points to all this is; apart from the Anglican Church covering-up the abuse of children in the Home, they are preventing victims from coming forward to receive adequate compensation for their abuse.

As the Primate - the leader of the Anglican Church – and a champion of the rights of abuse victims how about you have a good think about the duty of care lies. Think of the children who were abused in the Children's Home. Think of the guidelines in the **'Anglican Church Faithfulness in Service'** which you are obliged to follow. Think about how you would feel if you were abused in the same Home as I and I was doing the same to you.

Think about these words from family and friends of victims. (Please tell me if you require more details).

- **Several children who suffered abuse in the Church of England North Coast Children's Home have taken their lives, while others are broken shells of people. Others have been in and out of mental institutions; have succumbed to alcohol and drug abuse or have done time in jails struggling to cope with the consequences of the merciless abuse – that being the legacy of their years of torment in the Anglican Home.**

I want to know how the Anglican Church expects they will escape the blame of duty of care and child abuse. I want to know why the Anglican Church are being shielded and why the church are being protected at the expense of the children who suffered at its hand. *Why are you letting this happen?*

The Anglican Church's lies of child abuse are a criminal act. Over the last five years the Anglican Church has purposely lied to cover-up the abuse of children. The clear evidence that they blamed a fictitious "community group" for the abuse shows it is a criminal act.

\* The Anglican Church is guilty of intentionally with-holding evidence and lying of the truth of duty of care and child abuse in the Home to conceal their involvement in child abuse.

\* The Anglican Church is guilty of casting the blame of duty of care upon an unexplained group of people.

\* According to the Anglican guidelines in "Faithfulness in Service" the Anglican Church is guilty of negligence of its own duty of care.

I ask that you sit with Bishop Keith Slater (where you live in the Anglican Church supplied luxurious updated brick, two level \$2.6 million mansion in Ascot with five bedrooms, four bathrooms, one ensuite, two-car garage, fireplace, swimming pool and outdoor entertainment areas) with a nice strong cup of tea and think about all of what I have written in this letter (and many before). Tell the Bishop to pull his head in and put a stop to his stupid "community group" stunt and stop telling lies – lies that clear the church from blame of abuse but destroys the life of abused victims. Tell the Bishop the Anglican Church will never get away with lying about the abuse of the children? The truth prevails. Read your guidelines of duty of care and do your job!

I am having trouble understanding how those who purport to live by the moral values of God and the doctrine of the Anglican Church can tell such bold lies.
