Dear Tommy,

I write to thank you for the gracious manner in which you met with me on Sunday in spite of your deep hurts by the church and North Coast Children's Home. I have sincere sympathy with what you have set out to achieve and respect your courage and tenacity in seeking healing outcomes not only for yourself but for others who shared your ordeal in the Home.

I have today spoken with Michael Elliott and passed on your request that CA [REDACTED] be invited back to have her request for compensation reheard. I also alerted Michael to some of CA [REDACTED]'s fragility so that she might be appropriately cared for.

When I have prepared the Advertisement for the papers about which we spoke, I would like you to comment on it if you would, so that we might come to agreement that it covers the sensitive aspects that need to be said in such an apology and invitation to other abuse survivors to approach Michael.

√ [ I am very much aware of the significance for you of telling your story of the NCCH and your difficult experience in seeking support for all who have been abused at the Home, when you speak to the Royal Commission on Wednesday. I will pray for you Tommy that you will have clarity of thought and a real sense of peace as you play your part by telling of your experience. You are a courageous man with a genuine heart for others and I commend you. ]
