Re: Child Abuse / Duty of Care – Church of England North Coast Children's Home

Ms. Jenni Woodhouse told me it was okay to write to you.

Because of restraints at this time of the year I have written a few details below, however, I have also enclosed a copied letter I had sent to Ms. Jenni Woodhouse (which she said she never received).

There is a copied letter to Bishop Keith Slater (one which I send every week). Please note in that letters, Mr. Madden is mentioned. Mr Madden was a former DOCS manager in the DOCS office in Lismore. Mr. Madden had a close association with the Children's Home (as did other officers) for 11 years and they will all tell that the Anglican Church legally had the duty of care for the Home and not the fictitious "community group" that the Anglican Church have been blaming.

There is also a copied letter to various members of the Anglican Church clergy and a former member of the Children's Home committee.

The Anglican Church has repeatedly and shamelessly lied of the duty of care to escape their involvement with the Children's Home - they have caused much damage to abused victims all who are waiting for closure.

The Anglican Church is purposely with-holding information and distorting the truth of child abuse. They are concealing its involvement in the horrifying and sadistic acts of abuse of more than 100 innocent children.

I am referring to child abuse on a huge scale.

When I can, I will write you a more detailed letter of my truths and the Anglican Church's lies, but in the mean time I believe you would have much to go on. I wish you a good Christmas.
