Children's
 Home.

The Vicar stated there had been some
 doubt as to the connection the Children's
 Home had with the Church.

He wished to say that on looking up
 the constitution of the Children's Home
 he ascertained that the Church holds
 no responsibility in connection with
 financing the home. It was a diocesan
 institution controlled by a committee,
 and under the guidance of the
 church of England.

He also spoke of the great work of the
 matron Miss Caswell and also the
 splendid response he had received to
 the appeal for £500 or more to
 purchase a permanent dwelling
 He asked the council to help the
 home as much as possible in the
 future.

The Vicar also asked the hearty co-
