Dear Mrs. Dawson,

In response to your letter of 8.9.81

I can advise you that the Minister for Agriculture has exempted

North Coast Childrens' Home  
from the provisions of the Horticultural Stock and Nurseries Act,  
other than Section 14, in respect to the sales of horticultural  
stock at fetes, street stalls or other similar functions, provided:

- (i) sales of horticultural stock are not made on more than 4 occasions in each calendar year; and
- (ii) the period of sale on each occasion does not exceed 12 hours.

Section 14 of the Act only applies to the prescribed labelling of specific fruit crops, namely - apple, apricot, avocado, cherry, fig, grape, grapefruit, nectarine, lemon, lime, mandarin, orange, passionfruit, peach, pear, persimmon, plum, quince, strawberry, tangelo or tangor.

Permanent exemption unless revoked.
