> In consultation with you and the Bishop, I appoint a Facilitator. The Process is one where the Facilitator is to enquire into your needs. Hence, the arrangement to obtain Professor Dooley's Report which will inform the process. It is an opportunity for you to explain the impact of the abuse on your life. The Facilitation takes place in the context of a meeting referred to as the Facilitation meeting. The process is similar to that of a mediation. You should bring a support person with you to that meeting. This person might be a family member or a trusted friend. The aim of the Facilitation is to come to a resolution of the matter. The Facilitator assists you and the Church Authority in that process. When I have Professor Dooley's Report, I will speak to you about the appointment of the Facilitator. Early in the new year I will send you through an Authority to sign addressed to Professor Dooley authorising him to provide his report to me.
