Greetings once again DK

It was good to have a discussion with you on the phone this morning and I hope we are gradually moving the process forward. I am also attaching a copy of the Student Protection Protocol for the Diocese of Cairns which is used specifically by our school at Cairns in response to abuse matters.

One other point that I omitted to mention in our discussion was regarding legal advice. Assuming that we are able to work towards a mediated settlement for this matter there is usually a Deed of Release. I am sure you are familiar with such documents. Included in this Deed of Release is a statement that you have taken legal advice regarding the form of the agreement and where possible there is a statement from a lawyer indicating that they have viewed the agreement and have no concerns regarding its format. This in fact is a procedure that we usually adopt for your protection as well as ours. Most people we work with do have a lawyer look at the agreement and sign. Occasionally people say they do not want to have any lawyers involved at any level even in viewing the release. That is up to you but we strongly recommend that you do have a lawyer view the agreement. Once again I would like to say that if you wanted to have a lawyer with you and your wife during the discussion then we would be happy with that. This of course is not the full legal involvement as in civil litigation but more a legal assessment that everything has been done properly. In cases such as this the Marist Brothers would be prepared to pay moderate costs for a lawyer to view the agreement and even for one to sit in on the mediation meeting if that is your desire. My apologies that I omitted to mention that this morning.

I hope that as we move forward that you will feel some settling and peace of mind. Do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
