I confirm I conducted a mediation on Tuesday 20 April between Ms Joan Isaacs, with Mr Peter Deed as a support person and Fr. Adrian Farrelly.

The Agenda was apology, counselling and compensation.


These matters were discussed in some depth by those present. Ongoing discussions will take place in relation to compensation.

There were two matters of particular importance to Ms Isaacs. The first was the need for privacy surrounding the discussions. While she appeared satisfied about this by the end of the discussions, it was obvious that this element had been worrying her. The second was a request for some personal involvement of the Bishop or Arch-Bishop. While Fr. Farrelly responded in a most appropriate manner, Ms Isaacs was still of the view that the issues involved were not being addressed or acknowledged by those with most influence in the Church. She raised the suggestion of a day of reconciliation for those abused by the clergy.

I trust this report meets your needs.

I enclose my account for my services and thank you for the opportunity to mediate these discussions.
