In relation to the above matter and to your "without prejudice" counter offer of 20 April 2001, we have referred this counter offer to our client but we have genuine belief that it will be totally unacceptable.

When we receive instructions, we will revert. As you know, our Mr Moore has a one month complex trial that is running through the whole of May and on this basis Susan Bruggemann will communicate our client's instructions to you when they are to hand.

As soon as we receive them, we will let you know. We appreciate that your client is anxious but Mr Deed's continual phone calls to our office do become frustrating because we cannot respond until we have instructions. Our Mr Moore went to a lot of trouble to procure the previous offer which was a top of the limit figure. In any event, so there is no misunderstanding, the offer made in our letter of 20 April 2001 remains open for the purposes of the Uniform Civil Procedure Rules and also in terms of the principles of the Calderbank case.
