Dear Colleagues

The Corporation of the Trustees of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Brisbane -ats- Isaacs

We refer to the above matter and to our telephone discussion of 2 July 2001 (Mr Moore/Mr Deed).

The next step we were to take in this action was to apply to strike the action out. We are disappointed that we cannot reach agreement on the terms of settlement, particularly as we do not see there is any prejudice to Mrs Isaacs, and in fact the substance of the new Clause 9 is to her advantage.

If it is your client's position that she is only prepared to sign the first Deed that was submitted and she has received appropriate advice in relation to the varied Deed, including particularly Clause 9, then we are prepared to make a further effort to have the terms of settlement accepted by the various people we have to secure instructions through (which we indicated to Mr Deed is not anyone in Queensland). There was a suggestion that you thought Father Spence was being difficult over the matter. These matters have not been originated by anyone in Queensland.

Once we incur further legal defence expense, the offer previously made will not be revived. From a personal point of view, we think that would be a shame because we cannot see any basis upon which the action can succeed and the consequence of that would be a cost order against Mrs Isaacs,


