do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:

- 1. I am a practicing catholic and a parishioner of the Parish of Tweed Heads of which Father Rex Brown is Parish Priest.
- 2. I am a regular contributor to Parish Planned Giving Programme.

3. I live next door to the Presbytery in Tweed Heads, and, am at times, embarrassed by what I see & hear when there are visitors to the Presbytery. It would be impossible to relate each incident, but one, that stands out in my memory, was one evening when the language was so loud, that it must have been heard well down 'Francis', 'Pearl' Sts, and so farce

4. that my husband rang the Presbytery & told the young person who answered the phone, to please quieten down & cut out the farce language. otherwise he would notify the Police after putting

5. down the telephone that had told his female companion that some "shit" was complaining about their language & threatening to call the Police. I was advised that the two young people were were yelling obscenities at each other & the date had been making S.T.D. calls. Incidentally they stated this to the persons they were seeing.

6. At one time during 1984 there were at least three young men at a time living under the Pres. & their coming & going were advised to me because it was from our front door. I have seen both girls & boys coming out from under the house very early on numerous mornings & at one occasion two girls wearing school uniforms, were there for the best part of the afternoon. I make this declaration reluctantly, but aware that something must be done to restore the Catholic witness to the Presbytery & stop the scandal which appears to be widely spread.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act of 1900.
