3. I have worked as a barmaid for 3 1/2 years and I am able to tell when people are sober or intoxicated.
4. When Father Brown first came to the parish Mrs Brady my landlady introduced me to Father Brown by bringing him to my flat. It was clear to me that he was ~~was~~ intoxicated and he said to me "I will have to come up to Mrs's flat more often"; I replied "no you will not".
5. About 18 months ago Father Brown rented a flat beside mine; which was a one bedroom flat and put a number of unemployed young people in it. He had 8 to 10 people staying there from time to time.
6. I would have to phone the pres on a number of occasions and every time I spoke to him I could tell by his manner of speaking he was intoxicated.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act of 1900.
