Widow do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:

1. I am a practicing catholic and a parishioner of the Parish of Tweed Heads of which Father Rex Brown is Parish Priest.
2. I am a regular contributor to Parish Planned Giving Programme. and I have been a member of the Tweed Heads Parish for 77 years.
3. I have had Father Brown to my home on one occasion ~~for dinner~~ ^{to play cards} and in my opinion he was heavily affected by alcohol at the time of his arrival. This can be verified by Sister Martha who was also present.
4. I regularly attend morning mass and on occasions Father Brown did not attend to say morning mass. I am unaware of the reason for his non attendance.

I reside in the same street at the youth refuge and I have witnessed many unpleasant incidents involving the occupants of the refuge when they walk past my house late at night invariably intoxicated. I recently heard the following conversation between two occupants of the refuge outside my house at 10.30pm. "We haven't got any money for grog! what are we going to do now? Reply " We will go and call Father Brown, he will give us all the money we want.
