Dear Michael

I raised the question with you of possibly going to QLD for a mediation with a complainant, DK [redacted] **REDACTED**, against Brother Ross Murrin presently in custody. This is the man who has been approached by Jason Parkinson from Canberra to act on his behalf but he has chosen to follow the Towards Healing process. I am attaching my notes on the matter as well as a comment on a very recent conversation with him on the phone. It may be advisable for me to come in to discuss the matter but I will wait to hear from you on this.

As you see I have mentioned your name as mediator and he is happy with that. As there are 3 Brothers that taught him at the time that he has questions for. I have suggested him speaking with these Brothers in your presence before we start the formal mediation process. I do not think there is any need to have a big separation between this meeting and the mediation. As you note one of the Brothers, Peter Rodney, is overseas for 6 months and so it would be Brothers Gerald and Andrew who would be part of this discussion with Mr DK [redacted]. DK [redacted] is aware of the difficulties with Peter Rodney and is happy to go ahead. He seems genuine to me and mainly wants to let go of his anger and get on with life. Basically he is looking at a Tuesday and/or Wednesday meeting and would very much like to have the matter completed during March. I don't know how you are situated for possible days to travel to Brisbane which is where he lives. I have also to finalise with CCI what format they are happy with.

After you have read the material and we've (incl CCI) had a discussion we could look at whether there is a need for an assessment or a psych assessment. He mentions a totally separate case of specific sexual abuse in the College infirmary. I raised this issue with him after reading his statement and he indicated that this is not an issue for him and he does not want that to be part of the whole mediation process. He feels that the deepest impact on him personally and his relationships has been his contact with Brother Ross Murrin whom he regarded as a close friend and whom he still cares about even though he is angry with him. He was very interested to know how the Brothers are caring for Brother Ross at this time.

I look forward to hearing from you Michael as to the best way to proceed and am happy to come in when you have a moment.
