"Team Jennifer" helped me be resilient. My sister and brother are still grieving. I am starting to feel good now.

I got to say what was important. I am disappointed in Father Mulchay. But I will let that go. To receive the letter from the Bishop is **very important**. I have over the last days started to feel free of the blackness that has been part of me for so long.

I am grateful you will be at the meeting with the Bishop. My brother will fly in from Sydney to be with me. Even though the meeting is for me to talk with the Bishop, perhaps this will help him get closure too.

Again I just wanted to ensure you knew I genuinely appreciated you on Friday.

My husband and I are going on a holiday for a few weeks. We leave tomorrow. We are both still exhausted. It will be nice to get on that plane and leave the last weeks behind us
