It was good to have the opportunity to talk with you and REDAC. I am pleased your psychologist has recommended time off work. It will do you good, I am sure.

I am writing to confirm how The Salvation Army will help you at this time.

- we will cover the cost of the initial ten sessions of counselling with your psychologist, Dr Leigh Nomchong, after which we will review your progress with the option of funding further sessions if needed.

I understand you will not be claiming Workers' Compensation so will not be seeing the psychiatrist and your GP visits are covered by Medicare.

- we will arrange and pay for a one-off, two week break away.

As you know, I have arranged for two weeks in the flat above The Anchor in Newcastle. This is a crisis accommodation place for men. You will be separate to them with your own bathroom and kitchen facilities. Linen will be supplied.
