	<p><u>History</u> - ES parents separated when he was three years old. ES father was very punitive and on one occasion was charged and convicted of illtreating him. (ES was belted with a length of hose and suffered extensive bruising to his arm and buttocks). ES suffers from hereditary capillary fragility (an inherited functional defect of the small blood vessels throughout the body which tend to rupture easily and fail to arrest bleeding quickly.)</p> <p>It appears ES spent most of his early life in Institutions in Victoria and was a ward of that state until 9th February, 1972. In October, 1971 ES came to live in Townsville with his mother and her aeracto.</p> <p>In February, 1972 ES was admitted to Wilson Youth Hospital after having been committed to care and control by the Clerk of the Court, Charters Towers on the grounds that he was uncontrollable. ES had left Townsville, hitch-hiked to Charters Towers, stole a car in Charters Towers and was involved in an accident when he failed to take a corner and crashed into a fence.</p> <p>Wilson Youth Hospital reported that ES was a boy of average intelligence. Bender Gestalt borderline normal. Reading seriously retarded. Educationally seriously retarded.</p> <p>3rd June, 1972 ES was discharged from Wilson Youth Hospital to Endeavour Training Farm, Riverview.</p> <p>ES was returned to Wilson Youth Hospital from Endeavour on 11th January, 1973 because of persistent abscondings. On 29th March, 1973 ES was released from Wilson Youth Hospital to his parents in Townsville. His mother could see no point in ES continuing school as she felt some of his problems emanated from his dislike of school.</p>
