FX [REDACTED] is the brother of FV [REDACTED] FX [REDACTED] was spoken with at his home address in Queensland on the 12/6/98 by Police from Strike Force Cori. On that day he requested Police give him 24 hours to consider the matter.

On the 13/6/98 Police returned to speak with FX [REDACTED] and he supplied Police with the following information:-

- * FX [REDACTED] was institutionalised at the age of three and from that time he has been in and out of boys homes throughout Queensland and New South Wales.
- * FX [REDACTED] lived at Bexley Boys Home between 1974 and 1975.
- * The only incident of sexual abuse he recalls was an incident that he can only vaguely remember. He is unable to remember who the offender was. He would not elaborate any further on the incident.
- * FX [REDACTED] stated that he never witnessed any sexual abuse upon any of the boys in the home. He stated that the home however, believed strongly in corporal punishment.

FX [REDACTED] was unable to assist Police with the Bexley Boys Home inquiry.
