Detailed Report
<p>Under s.124C(3)(d) Children and Community Services Act 2004, you must provide details of the grounds for your belief that the above named child/ren has been the subject of sexual abuse or is/are the subject of ongoing sexual abuse. You may also provide information that you think is of concern and has informed your belief that child sexual abuse is alleged to have occurred or is likely to occur.</p> <p>The school has been made aware that in or around the Year 2000 whilst the child was a minor (9 - 10 years of age) that his teacher Mr YJ touched the boy on numerous occasions in a sexually inappropriate manner, including the touching of the boys genitals. This information has come to the school by way of a complaint from the complainant and his parents. The complainant and his parents have lodged a complaint with the Sexual Assault Division of the West Australian Police.</p> <p>Mr YJ is currently employed as a teacher at THE SCHOOL Preparatory School and he has been immediately stood down on full pay pending investigation by the appropriate authorities.</p>
