1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I am prepared to give to the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse. The statement is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
2. Where direct speech is referred to in this statement, it is provided in words or words to the effect of those, which to the best of my recollection, were used at the time.
3. My full name is **WP** and my date of birth is **REDACT** 1990. I am 23 years old.
4. I have given a previous statement to the Commission dated 14 May 2014.
5. I understand, from what staff and members of the Commission have told me, that the Commission is presently of the view that there is a suppression order, made by Judge Staude DCJ that prohibits the release of YJ's name and the name of The School to the public, in this Commission hearing. I have been told that because of this suppression order the Commission, nor any witness in this hearing is able to identify The School and the offender involved in this hearing.
6. I was not consulted by the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions when this order was applied for in the District Court in August 2012.
7. If in fact the suppression order has the effect contended by the Commission, I feel that YJ and The School are being unduly protected by this order.


- 8. I feel very strongly that both YJ and The School should be identified and named in this Commission hearing. I believe that other victims of YJ, if they exist, would more likely make complaint from knowing of the proven conduct of YJ whilst he was a teacher at The School.
- 9. I am aware that many people, including students, parents and teachers in The School community are already aware that I am a victim of sexual offences committed by YJ whilst he was a teacher at The School when I was a student there. I believe that it is quite unjust that I can be and have been identified in my community as being the complainant against YJ and also his victim, yet he and the School are to enjoy anonymity in the Commission’s hearings.
- 10. Attached and marked Annexure A to this statement is a copy of the Deed Variation signed by me on 5 May 2014 that permits the disclosure to the Commission of matters surrounding the settlement entered into with The School pursuant to the Deed of Settlement dated 12 December 2012.
- 11. I am also aware of existing media publications about The School. I have seen a copy of WQs statement and the publications Annexed to her statement, which identify both YJ and The School.
- 12. I give my authority, pursuant to s 36C(6) of the *Evidence Act* (WA) and s 171 of the *Criminal Procedure Act* (WA) for the publication and broadcast of my statements and my evidence in this Commission including when it contains the actual name of The School and of YJ.
