1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence which I would be prepared, if necessary, to give in Court as a witness.
2. The statement is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it anything which I know to be false or do not believe to be true.
3. I am 21 years of age.
4. I made a statement to Detective Feeney at the REDACT Police Station on the 27th of August, 1993. I detailed a number of Assaults that had been committed upon me by Stephen ROSER. I received a copy of my statement from Detective Feeney.
5. Since receiving my statement I have recalled a few things that I did not recall when I made my first statement. In Paragraph 17 of my statement I talk about Mr. Jordan and Adams becoming coaches, as well as Mr. Roser. I recall that Mr. REDACT, the father of REDACTED became a Swimming Coach as well.
6. In paragraph 6 I talk about how Mr. Noonan was my Coach for the 1984-85 Season. I forgot to mention that Mr. Noonan got some money from the club and obtained about 10 sets of harnesses. These harnesses were to be used in the water when swimming. The harnesses consisted of a belt with an elasticised rope that ran from the belt to the end of the pool. This allowed a swimmer to be in harness and to swim in the water without actually going anywhere. Additionally there were 10 pulleys that assisted swimmers to exercise their strokes on dry land.

7. The equipment was in use in the club for most of the 1984-85 swimming season. It was because we had this harness and pulley equipment that it seemed so strange that Mr. Roser made us use the "Technique" because there was nothing that the "Technique" could do, that I could see could not be accomplished by the Harness and Pulleys.

8. I also remember that when Mr. Roser and I were standing in the shallow end of the pool that the water was upto his waist whilst the water was about upto the middle of my chest.
