Further to my telephone call of 14 December 1994 I write to confirm the result of the above case.

The accused was dealt with at Port Macquarie District Court on 7 December 1994, before His Honour Judge GALLEN. In relation to the first count, against **RED** **REDACTED** he was convicted and placed on a recognizance for a period of three years, conditional upon him accepting the supervision of the Probation Service, and obeying all directions of that Service in relation to counselling and treatment. As to the second count, against yourself, he was also convicted and ordered to perform 200 hours Community Service, and to report, to that end, within 7 days to the Kempsey Office of the Probation Service.

As I foreshadowed before the sitting started, a large part of your Victim Impact Statement was objected to, but following negotiations, Part 5 of that statement was admitted into evidence. We thank you for your co-operation, time and effort in this regard. The accused was made aware of the contents of the statement. In conversation with the Probation Officer and in front of the Court on sentence, the accused expressed his great regret and sorrow for the problems and heartache caused you and your family.
