PRESENT: John Herington, D.M. Lismore C.S.C., Bronwen Myers, S.A.S., Kay Rolfe, Centacare, Judy Duggan and Sandra Freriechs, D.Os. Lismore C.S.C.

Discussion centred around the identification of children of whom Kay Rolfe was aware may have had further information to add to the investigations currently being undertaken by the Police Dept.'s C.M.U. Kay and Bronwen also discussed the need to meet with the parents of children who are involved in the investigation.

Kay has recently had an interview with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and their son, [REDACTED], who were regularly visited by Br. Gregory. [REDACTED] did not disclose abuse by Br. Gregory, but there is a younger daughter in this family [REDACTED] who has not been interviewed and may have been abused. Kay agreed to discreetly talk with [REDACTED] and refer her to D.O.C.S./C.M.U. and S.A.S., if necessary.

Other children identified as *possibly* having further information to aid in the C.M.U. investigation are [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. If C.M.U. wish to interview them further, officers may contact Kay Rolfe for home addresses/phone numbers. Kay Rolfe identified the families of the children to whom Br. Gregory was *attracted* as being families who have relationship problems.

OUTCOME: 1) Kay Rolfe to interview [REDACTED]

2) Kay Rolfe to assess the need for counselling of the parents of the children who have been involved in the investigation, with possible counselling on a joint basis with Centacare/S.A.S.

3) D.O.C.S. to advise C.M.U. of the names of other children who may have information to aid in the investigation - [REDACTED]. Their addresses and phone numbers are available through Kay Rolfe.
