COMPLAINT

I refer to my previous letter dated 21 December 2009.

I understand that you have discussed this matter with our lawyers, Griffin Legal. With your consent, your written complaint was forwarded to Queensland Police and the Australian Swimming Coaches and Teachers Association ("ASCTA").

The Queensland Police referred your matter to the Child Safety and Sexual Crime Group, who have informed our lawyers that, at your request, they will not be investigating your complaint further.

As I mentioned in my original letter, Swimming Australia takes all complaints seriously and will deal with each complaint in an appropriate manner having regards to the circumstances of each case. In your case given that the people involved are not current members or employees of Swimming Australia and may never have been, Swimming Australia will not be taking any formal action in relation to your complaint.

However, I hope you are somewhat reassured by knowing that in recent years Swimming Australia has developed Child Welfare Policies and Procedures designed to protect minors.
