




## Statement

1. This statement made by me accurately sets out the evidence that I am prepared to give to the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse. The statement is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
2. My full name is Lloyd Adam Babb SC.
3. I am the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP) for New South Wales (NSW). I have held that position since July 2011. As DPP I carry ultimate responsibility for the operations of the Office and for prosecutorial decisions. The Annual Report 2012/13 for the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP) is **Annexure A** to this statement.
4. I was admitted to practice as a solicitor in 1992. I have worked as a solicitor in private practice and at the Office of the DPP (ODPP). I was admitted as a Barrister in NSW in 1995. I practised in largely (but not exclusively) in the criminal law, both prosecuting and defending. I was appointed a Crown Prosecutor in 1999. I was an acting Public Defender between August 2006 and February 2007. I have been involved in the prosecution of dozens of trials involving allegations of child sexual assault. I have conferenced dozens of victims of child sexual assault. I have appeared in

many appeals from child sexual assault convictions and sentences. I was the Crown Advocate for NSW between February 2007 and July 2011. In that role I appeared in the first applications for orders under the Crimes (Serious Sex Offenders) Act (now called the Crimes (High Risk Offenders) Act 2006).


5. I have been involved in initiatives taken to attempt to improve the course of criminal justice in NSW in the area of child sexual assault. I was the Director, Criminal Law Review Division of the Attorney General's Department from December 2003 to December 2005. Throughout 2005 I was the Chairperson of the Criminal Justice Sexual Offences Taskforce which published the report *Responding to sexual assault: the way forward* in February 2006.
6. I have read the statement of Mr John Pickering SC, Deputy DPP, dated 27 June 2014 which has been provided to the Royal Commission. I agree with the content of the statement.
