- a. The Plaintiff has suffered significant psychiatric injury and continues to suffer Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
 - b. The Plaintiff has been affected in her capacity to maintain a normal lifestyle and has resorted to alcohol and drug use.
 - c. The Plaintiff has been incapable of maintaining relationships with her partners and has found it difficult, if not impossible to maintain a sexual relationship with her partners.
 - d. The Plaintiff has been incapable of maintaining a normal lifestyle or of looking after children and some of the Plaintiff's children have been put into the care of other people because of the Plaintiff's own inability to render assistance to her children.
 - e. The Plaintiff because of her psychiatric illness has not been capable of maintaining a steady lifestyle and has changed places of abode on many occasions.
