

MEETING WITH HEADMASTER KNOX GRAMMAR SCHOOL, JOHN WEEKS, AND GRAHAME WILSON, DIRECTOR COMPLIANCE AIS 8 MARCH 2007

Mr Weeks advised that he had received a complaint from an ex-student that POI had sexually assaulted him in 2003 when he was aged 16yrs. The POI at the time had been employed at LOI as Head of Pastoral Care. The POI had befriended the victim when he was in Year 7 at the school. One day, the victim was upset and the POI drove him home and offered to take him out to dinner and have a talk with him. The victim's mother agreed to this. The POI ended up taking the victim back to his residence, offered him a cigarette, then gave him a beer before indecently and then sexually assaulting him. The POI claimed "this is what we do". The victim resisted and became upset asking to be taken home. The victim subsequently disclosed the incident involved cigarettes and alcohol to his mother but did not disclose at that time in relation to the sexual assault. The investigation of that complaint resulted in termination of the POI's employment in 2004 and notification of relevant disciplinary proceedings to the CCYP.

The first complaint about sexual assault was made by the victim to his father and a fuller complaint made to the headmaster in January 2007.

The headmaster said that there had been a previous complaint in relation to the POI and a boy whom he had "brushed against" in a dark room in 1984/85. The boy was also aged 16yrs at the time. The headmaster advised that the POI is a keen photographer who has frequently travelled to Sth East Asian destinations and is travelling in more recent times to Africa.

The POI was an old boy of the school had been employed at LOI since 1976. Apparently, there was a previous investigation of allegations involving this POI and others conducted by the previous headmaster (who had also been in charge of the school for an extended period of time) but the report relating to this has apparently gone missing from school records. The victim does not wish to report the matter to police at this time. The headmaster has made contemporaneous notes of the victim's disclosure in case the victim may wish to make a statement to police at some time in the future.
