1. I have previously provided a statement to the Royal Commission dated 21 January 2016.
2. I have been asked by the Royal Commission to comment on the contents of paragraph 18 of Dr Ian George's statement dated 15 January 2016.
3. I have also been asked to comment on an email sent by me to Reverend Don Owers dated 27 March 2002.

## STATEMENT OF DR IAN GEORGE

4. Now that I have had an opportunity of reading Dr Ian George's statement, I recollect being asked by him to make some enquiries about the possibility of other CEBS members being abused by Brandenburg and if there were any past allegations made about Brandenburg. I am quite confident that I did not provide a written report to Dr Ian George. I have no recollection of preparing a report.
5. I did make enquiries. The outcome of those enquiries is that no report, formal or informal, in regard to abuse by Brandenburg had been made to me or to any other current responsible leaders of CEBS SA prior to his arrest. I most likely provided a verbal summary of the outcome of my enquiries to Dr Ian George.

## EMAIL FROM CONRAD PATTERSON TO REVEREND DON OWERS DATED 27 MARCH 2002

6. I have no specific memory of the email but accept that it was sent by me. I believe that the contents of the email sets out the situation as it stood at the time.
7. I do not have a recollection of the contents of the letter sent by Reverend Don Owers to the Archbishop dated 21 March 2002 which is referred to in my email to Reverend Don Owers.
8. A draft letter was prepared for the purposes of being sent to parishes and former CEBS but had been sent to the Archbishop for comment. I do not believe I received a response to that letter.
