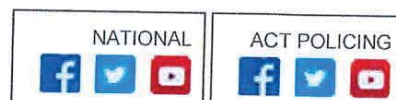

Name

Sexual Offences and Child Abuse Workshop

Purpose

To develop the skills and knowledge required to successfully and competently conduct complex, sensitive and / or protracted investigations for offences involving sexual assault and child abuse.

Who Should Attend

- Investigators within CI – ACTP;
- AFP members currently deployed to external territories, as due to their remote location, they may be required to investigate these crime types; and
- Investigators within regional offices of the AFP who may be called upon to respond to such offences.

It is expected that participants will be:

- Post probation; and
- Working in an investigations area or external territory; and
- Completed Phase 1 of the Detective Training Program or equivalent; or
- Competency in general investigational techniques including search warrants, standard tactical plans and statement writing; and
- Interest in investigating sexual assaults or offences against children.

Structure

The Sexual Offences and Child Abuse Workshop is a 1 week non-residential program which draws on the experiences of subject matter experts and program mentors to deliver relevant subject content. Prior to the workshop, members are required to review relevant legislation and pre-reading materials in preparation for the course.

Program Duration and Authorised Hours

5 days [40 Hours] of formal class participation plus two hours of pre-course reading and activities.
