Offence details

1. Between the 21st day of April and the 21st day of August 2010 at REDACTED and other places in the said State, indecently assaulted^(CDI) a child under the age of fourteen years.

Section 56 (1) of the Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 1935.

It is alleged that the further circumstances of aggravation are that the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim of the offence was, at the time of the offence, under the age of 12 years and the offender abused a position of authority in committing the offence the offender abused a position of trust in committing the offence and the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim was, at the time of the offence, in a position of particular vulnerability because of physical or mental disability.

This is a major indictable offence.

2. Between the 21st day of April and the 21st day of August 2010 at REDACTED and other places in the said State, indecently assaulted^(CED) a child under the age of fourteen years.

Section 56 (1) of the Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 1935.

It is alleged that the further circumstances of aggravation are that the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim of the offence was, at the time of the offence, under the age of 12 years and the offender abused a position of authority in committing the offence and the offender abused a position of trust in committing the offence and the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim was, at the time of the offence, in a position of particular vulnerability because of physical or mental disability.

This is a major indictable offence.

3. Between the 28th day of April and the 21st day of August 2010 at REDACTED and other places in the said State, assaulted ^{CEH} and other Section 20(3) of the Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 1935.

This is an aggravated offence.

It is further alleged that the circumstances of aggravation are that the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim was, at the time of the offence, in a position of particular vulnerability because of physical or mental disability and the offender abused a position of authority in committing the offence and the offender abused a position of trust in committing the offence.

This is a minor indictable offence.

4. Between the 21st day of April and the 21st day of August 2010 at REDACTED and other places in the said State, indecently assaulted ^{CEH} a child under the age of fourteen years. Section 56 (1) of the Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 1935.

This is an aggravated offence.

It is alleged that the further circumstances of aggravation are that the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim of the offence was, at the time of the offence, under the age of 12 years and the offender abused a position of authority in committing the offence and the offender abused a position of trust in committing the offence and the offender committed the offence knowing that the victim was, at the time of the offence, in a position of particular vulnerability because of physical or mental disability
