## Building a child safe sports organisation

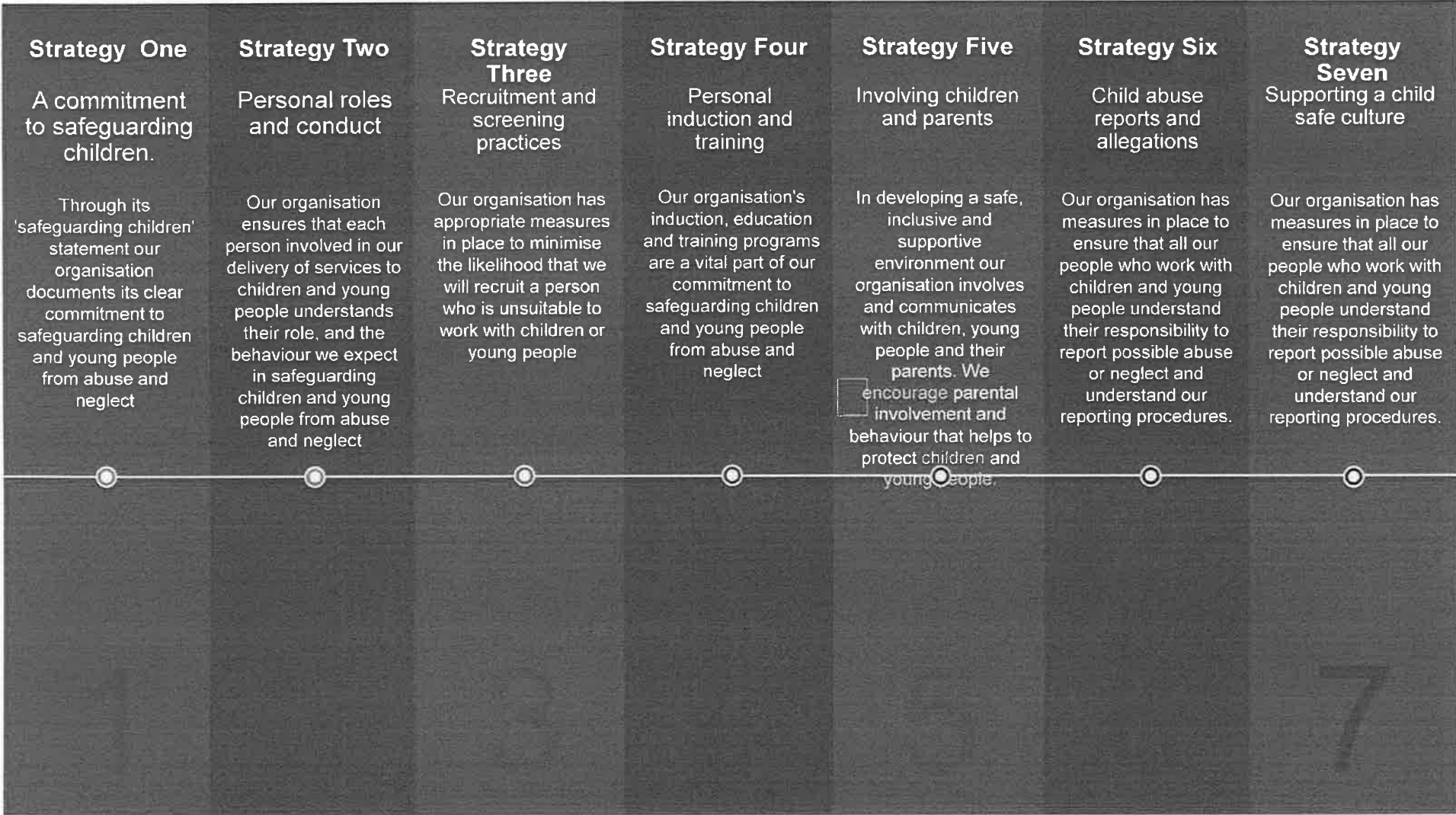

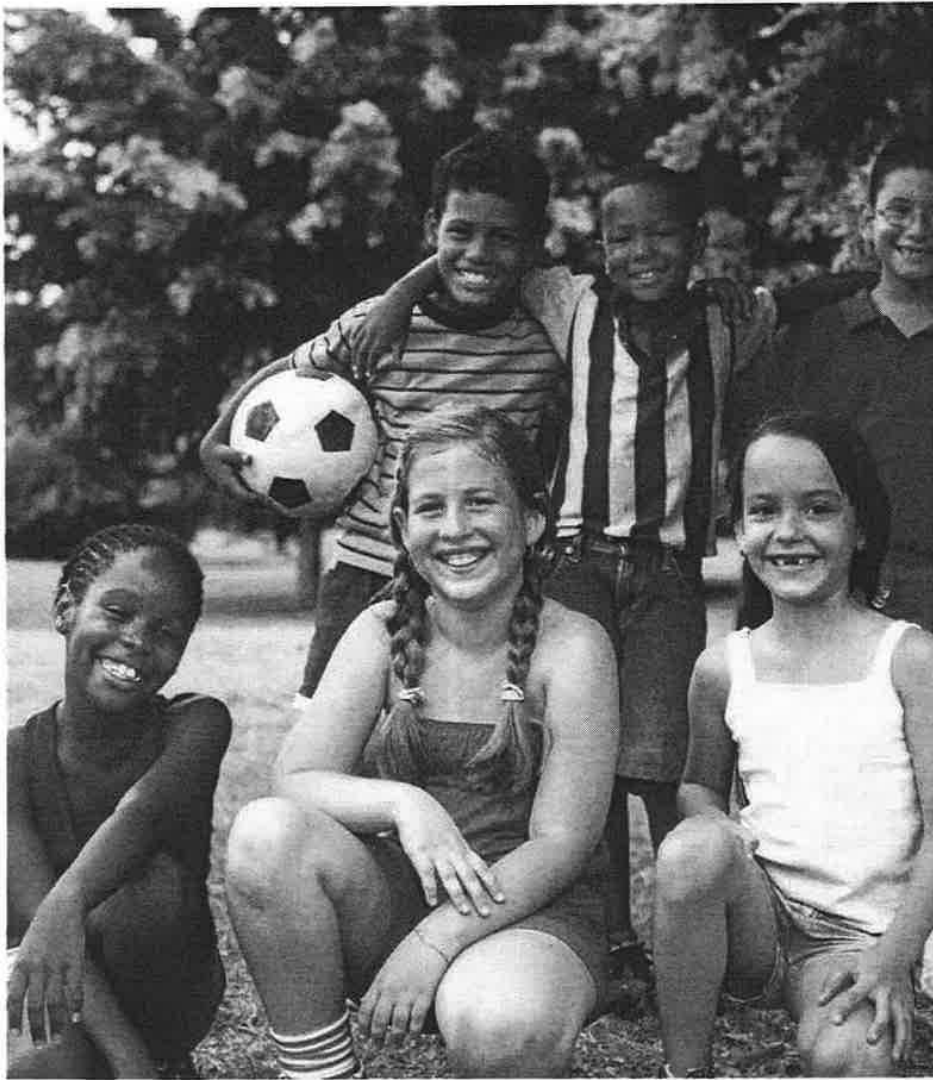

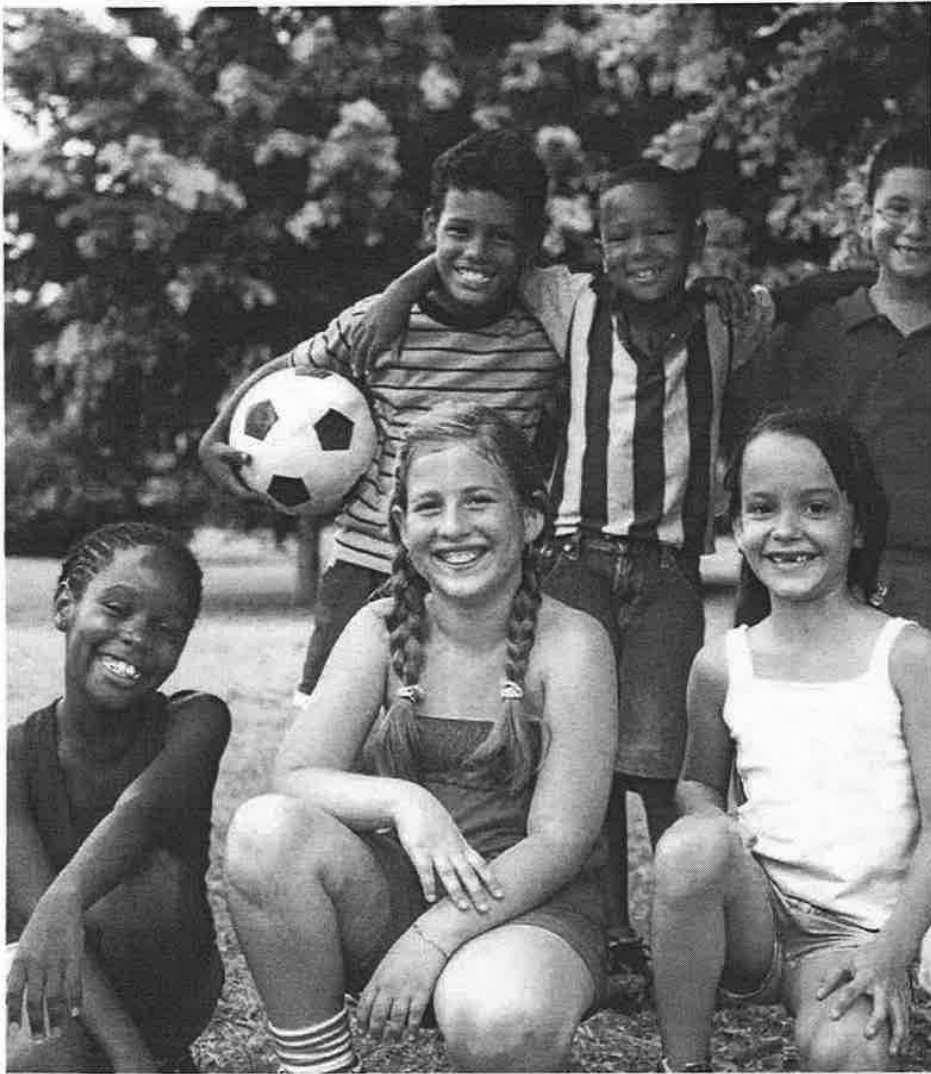
## Strategy One

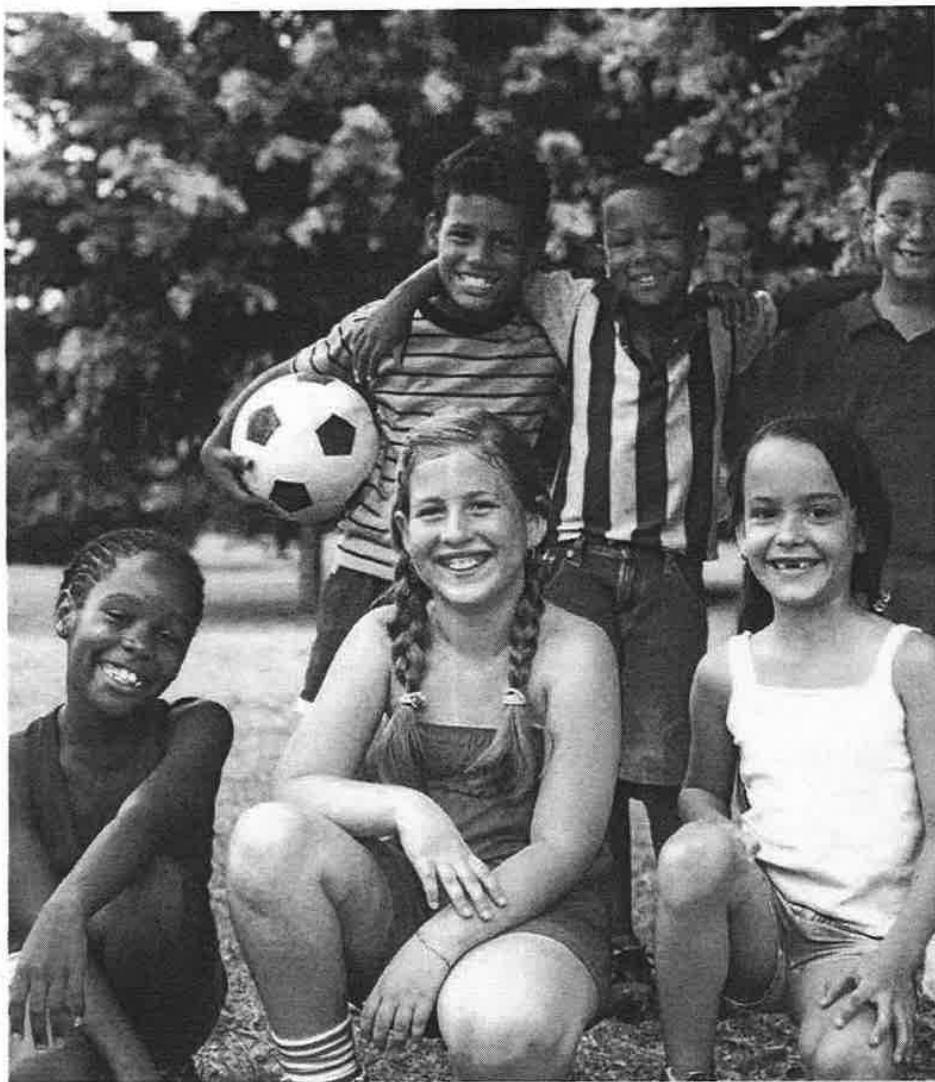
## Strategy Two

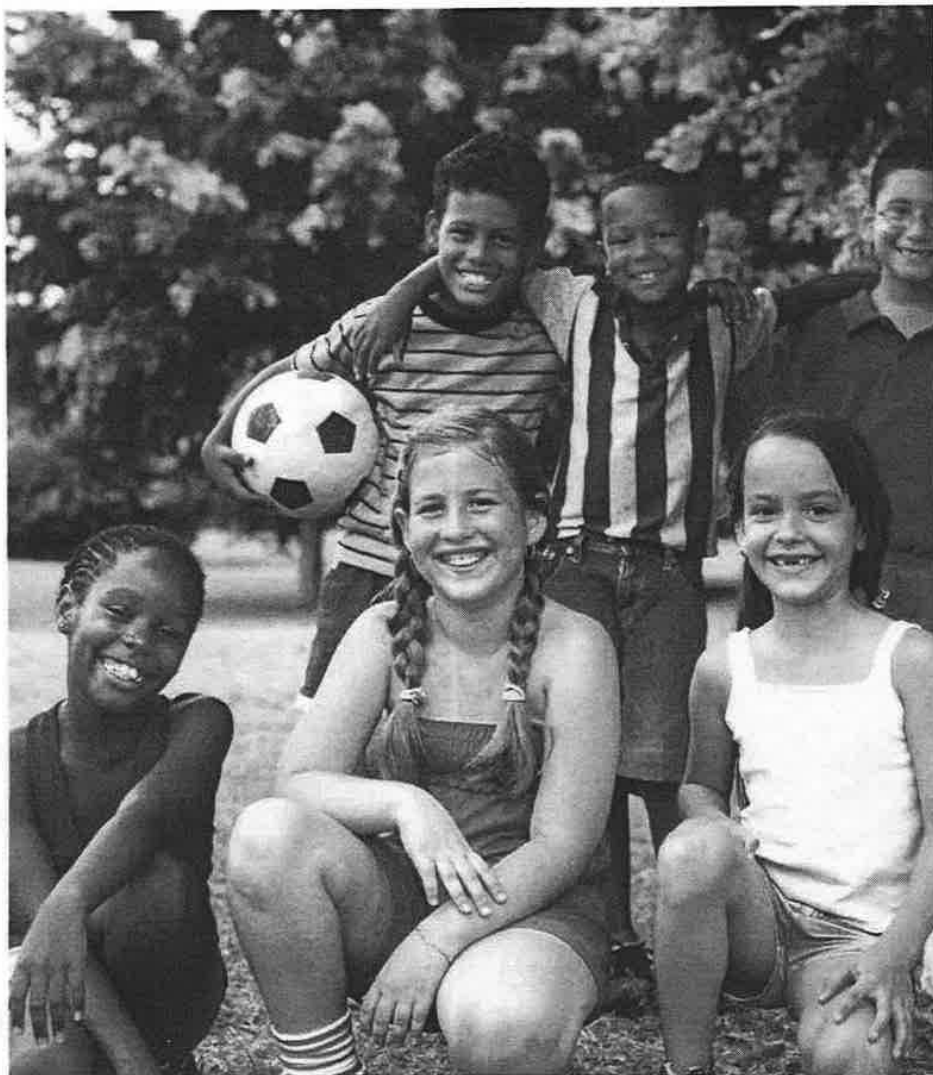

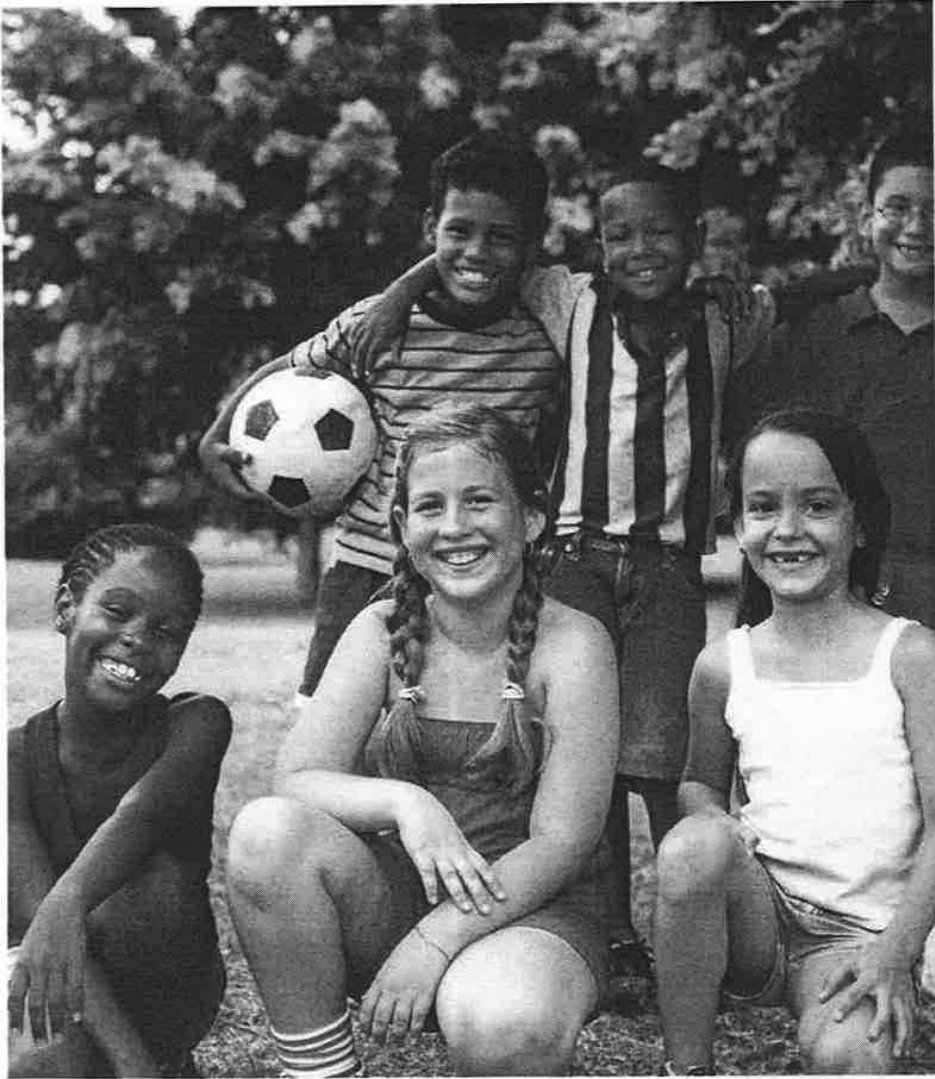

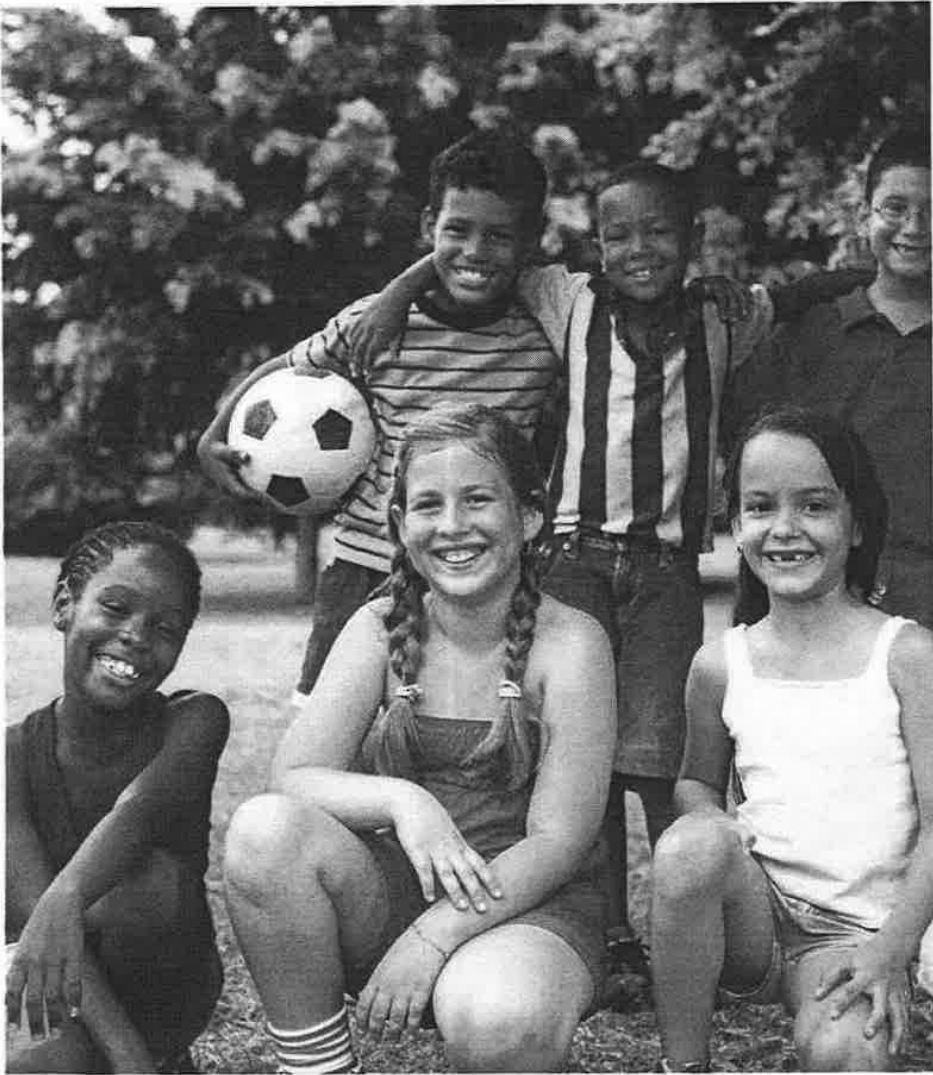
