I have recently become aware of a situation where a 232 SQN cadet has raised allegations of inappropriate behaviour against a senior cadet at the SQN. The accused cadet is over 18 years of age.

I was informed of this situation by the accused cadet yesterday (23DEC12); I have not been informed by any other source.

This afternoon (24DEC12), I spoke briefly to the accused cadet regarding the situation. Complaints relating to several alleged instances (spanning a period of time) of inappropriate behaviour have been made to the police by a single cadet; and as such, the complaint is being dealt with through the police / court system. The accused cadet informed me that the police indicated that they will be contacting the AAFC regarding this matter.

I wanted to make yourself aware of the situation in order for you to take any action necessary and to manage the situation as required. Whenever you have an opportunity, please contact me to discuss further if you require more details.
