Sir

Further to our telephone conversation this evening, the following information has been provided to me.

On 22 May 13 CSGT [REDACTED], 318SQN reported to his CO that he had earlier received a message through his facebook account from a CWOFF [REDACTED], CF378684 of 302SQN (17 old) that she had willingly slept with a male member of staff whilst attending the promotion course at RAAF Wagga in January this year. Further, in February this year he had a telephone conversation with CWOFF [REDACTED] where she declared that she had engaged in sexual activities with the staff member. The CSGT did not report the incident as he believed he did not have sufficient evidence to make such a report.

The staff member has been nominated by CSGT [REDACTED] as LAC(AAFC) Chris Adams, 8588680 of 308SQN, Maitland. I can confirm that LAC(AAFC) Adams was in attendance as a staff member on the January Promotion Courses and received a CAF commendation for his actions in preventing a major fire on base.

CWOFF [REDACTED] is the recipient of a Commendation for Brave Conduct.

FLGOFF(AAFC) Sharon O'Donnell, T/SOGT 3WG has been tasked with conducting an IAR into the matter. I have tasked SQNLDR(AAFC) Darren Banfield to mentor FLGOFF(AAFC) O'Donnell in this inquiry.

At this time only CSGT [REDACTED] has been spoken to. He was questioned by his CO and a copy of his questions and the CSGT's answers have been provided. The CSGT is fully aware that he will be further interviewed by the Investigating Officer.

I have briefed FLGOFF(AAFC) O'Donnell and highlighted the urgency of finalising this inquiry.

Further information will be provided when it is known.
