## National Police Certificate (NPC)

### Explanatory Notes

Legislation in various states and territories and the Commonwealth of Australia restricts the information that can be disclosed about a person's court outcomes unless specific exemptions apply under law. Legislative exemptions can include specific types of employment, voluntary work, licences or membership of a profession. The information provided will include all disclosable convictions or findings of guilt by a court.

A NPC may also include supplementary person history information which could include outstanding matters such as warrants or pending court cases. It is important to note that until a court order as to an outstanding matter has been determined by a court it cannot be regarded as a finding of guilt.

A pending charge is a charge of an offence that has not yet been disposed of by a court and can be disclosed in compliance with various state, territory and Commonwealth legislation and or processes governing the issue of pending charges by police officers.

It is not recommended that copies are made unless the person or organisation assessing the NPC can provide the individual with a guarantee that the contents of the certificate will be kept confidential, and the certificate itself is securely stored and disposed of when not in use.

To ensure a link exists between the recording of convictions by courts and the updating of police information and reference systems, this certificate only reflects the completeness and accuracy of those records on the date displayed on the front of this certificate.

This check has been conducted on the basis of the name and date of birth (date and/or fingerprints) supplied by the person as provided above. Every care has been taken to ensure the accuracy of the check; however, given that fingerprints are not taken by the police services in Australia in all instances, it is possible that the police information and reference systems may contain information recorded against this person under another name or alias.

### Security Notes

This document contains a number of inbuilt security features. The absence of any of the security features indicates that this is not an original document. If there is any doubt regarding the authenticity of this document, or validity of the information printed thereon, the issuing Australian Police Service should be contacted for verification.

### Security Features:

- **Thermochromic ink:** A Waterson's, when held up to the light multiple images of a padlock with two keys are visible. Fingerprint ink will also fluoresce on the reverse of document allowing blue, yellow and red when held under ultra violet light.
- **Microprint:** The words "POLICE" and "COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA" are printed in microprint. MICROTYPE which can be read through a microscope.
- **Images on the front are printed in Heat Sensitive ink.** When moderate heat or friction is applied they will fade or disappear completely.
- **UV Ink Images:** are printed in UV ink on the front. The images will glow or show flow when viewed under ultra violet light.
- **Fluorescent ink:** used for the fluorescent red ink.
