The research requested is to ensure that the Diocesan administration is not embarrassed tonight by not having potential answers to questions at hand.

On page 58 of the DC papers the amended 2011 Synod motion clearly indicated the will of the Synod by the negotiation (as I recall) between the Chancellor and Fr Howarth to have his clauses 3 & 4 removed, including 4b.

I think that my invitation to Geoff Spring goes beyond the present motion; as we agreed on Friday Michael Elliott could be an inflammatory presence that might cause an over-reaction by DC in its drafting of amendments to the current Ordinance.

In preparing for the special DC meeting tomorrow night (Monday) I would be helped if you could respond with information to the following questions:

1. Are there still contact persons operant?
2. In the Ordinance has 4.2 been followed?
3. 21.3 – it is quite possible that the Bishop might not be informed about any matter that the PSC is dealing with until that matter assumes gravity requiring action
4. Ordinance 23.1 – has the DC set a limit?
5. 24.2 Is there any such resolution? Is this the instruction to you to appoint?
6. 28: has the DC set any terms and conditions?
7. 31.3 – this is a very difficult proposition involving a Bishop in the process prior to a recommendation; this needs a reference to the Chancellor.
8. 39. C – could I appoint another Rector in a parish?
9. 45: are there regulations?
10. When did the respondents lodge their appeal to the Supreme Court?
11. When was the amended ordinance placed on the Diocesan web page?
