### Determination of the Redress Panel:

- A. The Applicant is eligible to receive assistance.
- B. A monetary payment in the sum of \$54,000 will be made to the Applicant.
- C. A further payment in the sum of \$5000 for counselling and psychological care costs will be made to the Applicant.
- D. The Panel noted that the Applicant had received a letter of apology dated 16 May 2016 from Melinda Crole, as Chief Executive Officer of YMCA Australia and Haydn Robins as Chief Executive Officer of South Australia. The YMCA's Approach to Redress principles emphasise that the purpose of any apology by the YMCA is in every way to meet the wishes of the survivor.

The Panel hopes that the relief provided by the YMCA under the Approach to Redress Scheme will assist REDACTED to recover as much as possible from the effects of the abuse to which he was subjected.
